Berkshire Railway Museum Keeps Rolling with Americlean

When Tom Delasco of the Berkshire Scenic Railway Museum, Inc. in Lenox MA needed a company to clean and paint some 80-year-old railroad cars, he knew who to call. "Americlean was doing a project for a company I worked with in the past and everybody was pretty happy with the outcome there." Tom stated.

The five cars needed to be restored to the original colors of the railroad that they came from. Americlean used a sandblasting recovery system, that blasts and collects at the same time to remove old paint, as we wanted no chance of contamination to the ground or the air. After the rust-inhibitive primer was applied a special topcoat designed for high visibility areas was used.

We worked in an uncontrolled environment. It went from 90 degrees to thunderstorms to leaves and bugs flying into the fresh paint, sometimes requiring us to repaint.

Tom Delasco was pleased with the outcome. "Those cars are real nice looking now" he said. "Americlean did an outstanding job, especially overcoming all of the obstacles they had to deal with."
